Position:

Incorporation of POSTDOCTORAL research staff to the Institut d'Investigació i Innovació Parc Taulí (I3PT) through the "Ramón y Cajal (RyC) 2024" grant.

Location:

The selected candidate will join the Fundació Institut d'Investigació i Innovació Parc Taulí (I3PT).

I3PT has been a CERCA center since 2021 and was accredited in 2023 as an IIS by the Instituto de Salud Carlos III (ISCIII). It is a biomedical and hospital research and innovation center focused on generating value by promoting patient well-being as well as social and economic growth.

I3PT manages and coordinates all R&D&I activities of the centers within the Consorci Corporació Sanitària Parc Taulí (CSPT): Corporació Sanitaria Parc Taulí (which includes the hospital, diagnostic center, mental health center, genomic medicine center, and two primary care centers), Sabadell Gent Gran (geriatric residence), Fundació I3PT, and all research personnel from the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB) associated with the institute through agreements.

The Institute currently comprises 28 accredited research groups structured within seven priority knowledge areas, based on the prevalence of diseases in the region and unmet needs in these fields. These areas are: Cancer; Mental Health and Neurosciences; Metabolism and Digestive System; Rare Diseases; Epidemiology, Care Improvement, and Chronic Diseases; Infections and Immunology; and Surgery and Interventional Procedures.

In addition, I3PT has two strategic research areas that are transversal: Omics Sciences and Data and Technological Innovation in Health. These two areas are strategic fields shared with our hospital, the core of our Institute, and foster the execution of projects aimed at their clinical application from the outset, especially in the fields of omics bioinformatics and data science.

We are currently seeking POSTDOCTORAL research personnel interested in joining our institution through a "Ramón y Cajal 2024" contract, a competitive call issued by the Agencia Estatal de Investigación (AEI).





Responsibilities:

- Join a research group to design, plan, and lead competitive projects at the national and regional levels.
- Publish scientific articles.
- Work to meet the institution's accreditation requirements.
- Collaborate with researchers within the institution and with those from other institutions, particularly at the international level.

Workplace:

Fundació Institut d'Investigació i Innovació Parc Taulí (I3PT), located at Plaça de la Torre de l'Aigua s/n in Sabadell, Barcelona.

Requirements:

- Hold a PhD degree, obtained between January 1, 2014, and December 31, 2022.
- Have not been a beneficiary of a previous Ramón y Cajal grant.
- Not be a beneficiary of any Juan de la Cierva grant (of any type).
- Submit only one application to the "Ramón y Cajal 2024" call.

What we offer:

Integration into our institution for five years, divided into two phases: the 1st phase with a minimum duration of 3 years, and the 2nd phase with a maximum duration of 2 years. To access the 2nd phase, the researcher must undergo a scientific-technical evaluation (R3 criteria).


Financial allocation of €37,800 gross annually for the first three years. Upon obtaining the R3 certificate, the remuneration during the 2nd phase will be €46,900 gross annually.

Possibility of continued employment after completing the Ramón y Cajal 2024 contract.

AEI Evaluation Process:

According to Article 17 of the regulatory bases of the "Ramón y Cajal (RyC) 2024" competitive call, the evaluation of candidates' applications will be carried out in a single phase, as established in Article 21 of the regulatory bases, under the responsibility of the Subdivision for Coordination and Evaluation.

Expert technical committees, formed based on thematic areas, will adopt a single evaluation for each application by consensus, according to the criteria and sub-criteria listed in Annex I of the call bases.







The evaluation process may include in-person interviews or videoconferences.

Applications scoring 80 points or higher in each thematic area will be proposed for funding, up to the limit of the available grants for each thematic area.

Information, Application, Documentation, and Deadline:

Interested individuals must participate in the "Ramón y Cajal 2024" competitive call issued by the Agencia Estatal de Investigación (AEI) **before January 21, 2025, at 14:00** via the <u>AEI platform</u>.

Once the grant is awarded, the candidate will have the opportunity to join I3PT and become part of the institution's accredited research groups.
